Objectives and Outcomes

The Asia-Pacific region, home to over half of the world's population, is defined by diverse healthcare systems, socio-economic contexts, and cancer challenges. High-income countries lead in advanced diagnostics and treatments, while low- and middle-income countries (LMICs) face significant inequities in access, late-stage diagnoses, and limited infrastructure. These disparities translate into preventable suffering and loss of life for millions.

Set against the historic **Kumbh Mela** in Prayagraj, symbolizing unity and shared purpose, this summit seeks to transform cancer care by leveraging collaboration, innovation, and resources across the region. By bridging divides, the event emphasizes solutions that utilize expertise from high-income regions to address the unmet needs of LMICs.

The **''Equity in Action: Driving Progress in Cancer Care''** summit unites political leaders, healthcare experts, patient advocates, industry representatives, and researchers, driven by a shared vision of achieving equity in cancer care. This event provides a platform to address these disparities through meaningful dialogue, innovative solutions, and sustainable partnerships.

Objectives

- Strengthen Regional Collaboration: Develop actionable frameworks to address inequities in cancer prevention, early detection, and treatment across diverse healthcare settings.
- **Promote Innovation**: Leverage cutting-edge technologies such as AI, precision medicine, and translational research to improve diagnostic and treatment outcomes.
- **Mobilize Resources**: Foster sustainable financing mechanisms and public-private partnerships to build capacity and scale cancer care solutions.
- **Empower Patients**: Center the voices of patients and advocates to ensure ethical and patientcentered innovations drive healthcare policies.
- Formalize Commitments: Unite stakeholders to adopt the Asia-Pacific Declaration on Cancer Care, reinforcing shared responsibility and accountability.

Expected Outcomes

- Establishment of a **regional task force** for cancer care collaboration and policy alignment.
- Concrete recommendations for integrating advanced diagnostics and innovations into national healthcare systems.
- Strengthened partnerships between governments, NGOs, and industry to address gaps in access, affordability, and infrastructure.
- A formal declaration of commitments through the Asia-Pacific Declaration on Cancer Care, ensuring sustained efforts toward equitable care.
- Empowerment of patients and communities as key stakeholders in cancer care and policy discussions.

This summit, inspired by the symbolic unity of the **Kumbh Mela**, seeks to foster mutual growth, shared accountability, and measurable progress, ensuring that advancements in cancer care benefit all.
